June 9, 2010

The brief meeting was called to order at 7:45 p.m. in Blue Rocks Box #301, Judy Johnson Field, Daniel Frawley Stadium.

We will have a short meeting/picnic at Gail's sometime after Labor Day. At that time we will discuss the slate of Officers/Directors for the next Alumni Assoc. Board. Everyone's terms have one more year with the exception of Nancy and Jay Mahanna. It's time for all of us to come up with some suggestions to carry our Association forward. Gail explained that different Directors do various jobs depending on what is happening at that time. We need a sub-committee for the Wall of Fame; one person can't take care of everything involved and we need ideas to get this going.

The Relay for Life went well and Mary Lou reported that one group raised \$8,000 for the event.

Brad reported from Brian Corey, Assistant Athletic Director at NHS, that the participation for the Golf Outing has been spotty. Brian said this would probably be the last year the event would be planned.

Gail reported that there have been no requests for NHS Alumni License plates and that we will clarify our standing with the IRS.

Debbie Lindell who is our webmaster has requested help. She's ready to pass this job on to someone new. Andre Harris volunteered to do this and Gail will put him in touch with Debbie.

Mary Lou reported that she is waiting for the 2010 yearbook supplement and graduation DVD so she can complete the 2010 keepsake box. Monika put Mary Lou in touch with someone who will collect items for the 2011 box.
